Tuesday, Feb. 12th Grade 5 students in Mme Johnston's, Mr. Cormier's and Mme Maxan's homeroom classes will be participating in the SJPF sponsored DARE (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) program. Thank you to Cst. Don Metcalfe for working with our students as part of the SJPF DARE program.

Wednesday, Feb. 13th is Fluoride Mouth Rinse Day. This program is a free and effective way to prevent tooth decay in children. Parental consent forms are required to participate in this program. Thanks you to our parent volunteers who help support this weekly oral health program.

Thursday, Feb. 14th Energy and Resource Development will be visiting Grade 4FI students in Mme Johnston's homeroom class and Mme Little's homeroom class. The presentation will focus on the plentiful and diverse nature of the natural wealth that we have as a province. This presentation aims to recognize specifically that NB forest are our premier resource and identify some related management techniques. Lastly, this presentation will help foster positive attitudes towards natural resources in NB and demonstrate the different ways that the children themselves can become managers of NB wealth by making responsible and conservation minded decisions.
