The YMCA Glen Carpenter Centre is a hidden gem; a forested hideaway with a sparkling private lake just minutes from Saint John's city center. Located in the heart of the City of Saint John, Rockwood Park offers 2,200 acres of unspoiled natural beauty, with ten lakes and 55 trails and footpaths. A Stonehammer Geopark site, Rockwood's billion years of history can be seen in unique rock formations, caves, and waterfalls. Students will discover all the fascinating treasures in New Brunswick's all season natural amusement park. Consent forms are required to participate.
