We are excited to let you know that Loch Lomond School and The YMCA have partnered to bring an After School Program to LLS to better serve our families. Work is underway to acquire a license and the program will open September 2nd.

The YMCA of Greater Saint John has been serving the Saint John community for the past 165 years and currently operates 10 After School Programs from St. George to Quispamsis serving 23 schools. Their National YMCA After School Curriculum, [A Place to Connect](#), is based upon building relationships with children and programming to their interests and choice. Children will enjoy a wide variety of indoor activities, centres and projects as well as gym and outdoor play and a healthy snack each day. As well the YMCA maintains very high Child Protection standards with policies in place and training for all staff so parents can feel safe while they are at work and their children are well cared for.

Once registration forms are complete, they can be returned to the school office. They will be accepted on a first come first serve basis and spaces are limited.
