This is Greg Norton calling from Loch Lomond School, with a few updates regarding upcoming events at Loch Lomond School for Friday, May 17th – Friday, May 21st.

May 17th – 21st all Grade 4 students at Loch Lomond School will be writing the Grade 4 Provincial Assessment. The Grade 4 assessment is part of New Brunswick's Provincial Assessment Program. Students will be assessed on reading: English (all students); French (only for French Immersion students). Each assessment also includes a short student survey about literacy. To reduce pressures on students due to the pandemic, the science and mathematics components of the assessment will not be included this year. Students are given 60-120 minutes for each subject.
