This is Greg Norton calling from Loch Lomond School, with a few announcements regarding upcoming events at your school for the week of **May 21st – May 25th**.

Our School Cash Online is now live and running. You must be registered/signed-up before the end of the day, Thursday, May 31st.

An important reminder that parents/guardians are asked not to drop students off at school prior to 7:50 a.m. in the morning. Faculty and staff are on duty at 7:50 a.m. and we appreciate your cooperation with not dropping your child off prior to this safe student drop-off time.

Provincial Assessments at Grade 2 and Grade 4 are scheduled to begin starting in the timeframe of May 22nd – June 1st. The Grade 2 Provincial Assessment will assess reading for English. The Grade 4 Provincial Assessment will assess reading for English and French, Math and Science. May 21st is *Victoria Day* and there will be no classes on this statutory holiday.

May 22nd we will be hosting *Yo-Yo Empire* for a school-wide assembly. This assembly is sure to be fun, exciting, educational, interactive and inspiring with a great message for our students – that "school is cool!"
