• November 19th students will receive Home Report #1. Distribution of home reports will take place at the end of the school day for all students. There is a parent/student response form attached to your child's Provincial Report Card. We request that parents complete, sign and return this form to your child's homeroom teacher.

• November 20th is National Child Day. National Child Day has been celebrated across Canada since 1993 to commemorate the United Nations' adoption of two documents centered on children's rights: the <u>United Nations Declaration of the Rights of the Child</u> on November 20, 1959, and the <u>United Nations</u> <u>Convention on the Rights of the Child</u> on November 20, 1989. Celebrating National Child Day is about celebrating children as active participants in their own lives and in communities, as active citizens who can and should meaningfully contribute to decision-making.

• November 21st is Fluoride Mouth Rinse Day. This program is a free and effective way to prevent tooth decay in children. Parental consent forms are required to participate in this program. Thank you to our parent volunteers that help support this oral health program.

• November 21st is a fundraiser for the 106th Empty Stocking Fund Telethon, which will feature our Grades 3-5 choir performing on stage at the Saint John High School auditorium on Saturday, Nov. 24th. The fundraiser for this event will take place after school on Wednesday, Nov. 21st from 3:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m. Students in Grades 3-5 can wear their pajamas to watch a movie and enjoy popcorn in the school gymnasium.
