- November 5<sup>th</sup> is our kick-off to financial literacy month. With that we welcome the team from Credit Counselling, who will deliver their Financial Literacy Read Event for our Grade 4 students. Financial literacy is having the knowledge, skills and confidence to make responsible financial decisions. Throughout the month of November, all Canadians are encouraged to invest in their financial well-being. This means taking control of their finances and reducing financial stress by making a budget, having a savings and debt reduction plan, and understanding their financial rights and responsibilities.

The Early Years Evaluation – Direct Assessment is an assessment that measures a child's kindergarten readiness skills. All children in the province of NB entering kindergarten in September will participate in this assessment.
