Each year approximately 2,500 people visit the Glenn Carpenter Interpretive Centre, located on-site at the landfill and Loch Lomond School is proud to be a part of this educational program tour.
- Oct. 16th All Aboard for Mrs. Gillespie's, Mrs. Crealock's, Mme Little's and Mme Johnston's Homeroom classes who will be travelling to Harbour Station to board the NBM Railways. This annual trip is made possible by NBM Railways and is an excellent way to celebrate the beginning of a great new school year.
