*The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development has been conducting school improvement surveys for several years. These have included all parents, all teachers, and students in grades 4-12 in all schools. The surveys focus on characteristics of schools that are related to school effectiveness and are used for planning and improvement for schools, districts and the department.*

*This year, the Department will begin a new survey cycle whereby all schools will receive the full set of three surveys every two years. Teacher surveys will continue annually. In addition, schools participating in the provincial school improvement reviews (15% of schools chosen at random each year), will also receive all three surveys.*

*For our school, this means parent and student surveys will be distributed next school year.*
