For the past 3 years the Saint John Community Loan Fund has been working with youth in Saint John to learn about, and actually start a business. We provide a unique opportunity to youth between the ages of 12-15 to be creative and possibly earn a bit of money. We partner with groups like the YMCA, the Multicultural and Newcomer Resource Centre, the Boys and Girls Club, local schools, and the Crescent Valley Resource Centre.

The successful candidate will have some background in business; perhaps running their own summer business or working with a family business. Most of all you need to have energy, creativity, a desire to work with youth, and the ability to be self-directed. You work easily with all Microsoft Office programs as well as the internet, and social media. Having a car would help but not entirely necessary.

We will provide the program outline, materials, the contacts, an enterprising support staff, a laptop and a desk. Plus we will pay you \$12.00 per hour, 35 hours per week, for 14 weeks, starting May 28, 2012.
