

Frequently Asked Questions about Registration:

I did not get the CR for a course. Should I register for that course again?

Answer: If you need it for post-secondary you may want to take it again. Taking it again will get rid of the enrolled. Make sure you have enough credits to graduate.

If I get an ENR for a course, am I allowed to take that course again?

Answer: Yes, just watch how many credits you need for graduation.

If I get a CR for a course, am I allowed to take that course again?

Answer: If you get a credit and get no mark you can take it again, however, be aware of your credit count for graduation.

If I retake a course will I still get ENR/CR on my transcript?

Answer: No, you will get a credit. It will show a credit of one and you will get a mark.

Will I still be able to change courses in the Fall if I change my mind on the courses I picked?

Answer: Yes, contact guidance or administration in September.

If I was not passing a course at the time of the closure should I re-take it?

Answer: If you need it for post-secondary, it would be recommended to take it again. Always be aware of your credit count for graduation.

How do I sign up for Co-op?

Answer: Sign up through Power school but remember that your attendance and behaviour will decide whether you get into the program.

How do you sign up for AP courses?

What do I do if I have trouble picking my courses online? i.e. can't get on, technical issues, no idea what to pick?

Answer: Contact your homeroom teacher.

What happens if I am unable to pick my courses?

Answer: Contact your homeroom teacher or an administrator.

How do I get my forms for co-op if I need references from teachers?

Answer: Forms are not needed. Register through Power School. Acceptance will be based on attendance and behaviour.

If I was on track and failed courses the first semester will I be able to go to summer school to graduate?

Answer: Yes, if summer school is offered.

Do I register for regular English courses if I plan on getting out of the French Immersion program?

Answer: No, register in French and let Mr. Langille know.

Do students going into grade 10 need to take both Geometry Measurement and Finance 10 AND Numbers Relations and Functions 10?

Answer: Yes.

What if a student does not know what course level to take?

Answer: If the student is unsure, they should contact the subject teacher.

How does the student know what the prerequisite is for the course they want to take?

Answer: The student can refer to the course registration PowerPoint on the school website.

Can a current grade 9 student retake grade 10 Science if they want to be better prepared for Chem 112 or Physics 112? (Those are the 2 units covered in Science 10)?

Answer: Yes, however they would have to drop one of their credit courses in order to take Science 10.
