1) TD Scholarships for Community Leadership

Value: 20 @ up to \$70,000

Criteria: outstanding community leadership and strong academic performance

Deadline: December 6, 2013

2) Burger King McLamore Foundation

Value: up to \$50,000

Criteria: this application is open to any students with an average of 75% and higher

3) Terry Fox Humanitarian Award Program

Value: multiple at \$7,000 per year

Criteria: The applicant must be entering a first year post-secondary program, be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant, and have demonstrated courage in overcoming an obstacle.

Deadline: February 1, 2014

4) Fred Rodd Scholarship

Value: \$2,000 x 4

Criteria: The applicant must be a student who is in grade 12 pursuing post-secondary education in visual arts or fine craft.

5) Dialogue New Brunswick Scholarships

Value: \$1,000

Criteria: the applicant must be able to describe how their extracurricular activities and community involvement promotes the values of mutual understanding, respect and appreciation between New Brunswick's English and French speaking communities.

Application: must be done online @ www.dialoguenb.org

Deadline: April 18, 2014

6) CUPE Local 380 (school bus drivers, custodians, and maintenance)

Value: \$250

Criteria: the applicant must write a 250 word essay on why organized labour has been important and why it is more important than ever in today's working society.

Deadline: Essay must be handed in to Mrs. Taylor or Mr. Macdonald by April 23, 2014
