HOW NB-TAP WORKS

- NB-TAP will begin this year as a pilot program with Simonds High School, Irving Oil and Jacobs Industrial.



Explore career options and learn life-long skills through paid workplace experience – while you're still in high school!

- As the program grows it will include other schools, companies and contractors from across New Brunswick.
- The program begins in grade 10 with a combination of exciting, hands-on work experience with a contractor, and classroom learning at Simonds High School.
- Work terms with Jacobs Industrial will take place at the Irving Oil refinery during the summer months.
- During the 14 week Co-op placement in grade 12, students will spend half their day at the refinery in the trade they've chosen.
- By the end of the program, students will have enough hours to complete the first block of their apprenticeship in their chosen trade.
