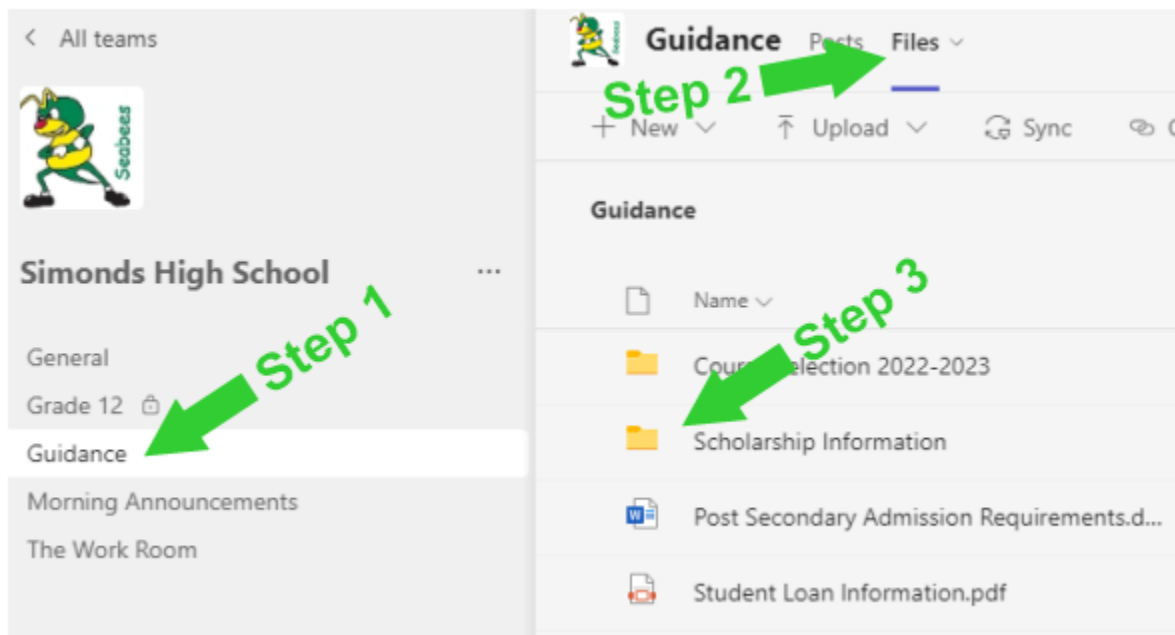

Whereas RUSI-NB is an association of serving and retired members of the Canadian Armed Forces, Cadet Instructor Cadre, Royal Canadian Mounted Police, other police services and other persons interested in Canadian defence, national security and public safety;

And whereas RUSI-NB wishes to encourage a greater awareness of the importance of the above matters among the general population;

And whereas RUSI-NB aims to support those serving their country in the Canadian Armed Forces Primary Reserve and in Navy, Army and Air Force cadet units;
