

# SUMMER SCHOOL 2012 – Saint John High School

School District 8, in partnership with **READ Saint John**, will be holding a Summer School at Saint John High School for Grades 8-12 students in School District 8 and neighbouring districts. There will be three components as follows:

- **Grades 8, 9, and 10 (July 3 – July 27, 2012)**- Students may enroll in **ONE** or **TWO** of the following courses for a flat fee of \$200.00:
  - English 8, 9 or 10
  - Mathematics 8 or 9
  - Number, Relations & Functions 10
  - Geometry, Measurement & Finance 10

To enroll in these courses, **students require the permission of their school principal and a minimum mark during the school year of 50% or letter grade equivalent.**

- **Grades 8-12 English as Another Language (EAL) (July 3 – July 27, 2012)** – Fee \$200.00

- **Grades 11 and 12 (July 3 – August 3, 2012)** - A variety of courses will be offered. Students may enroll in one course for a fee of \$250.00, or in two courses for a fee of \$300.00:
  - Biology 112, 113, 122
  - Chemistry 112, 122
  - Economics 120
  - English 112, 113, 122, 123
  - Environmental Science 122
  - French 112, 122
  - Geography 120
  - History 112, 113, 122
  - Law 120
  - Mathematics 112, 113, 122, 123, 120
  - Physical Geography 110
  - Physics 112, 122
  - Other 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> year courses if there is sufficient interest

To enroll in this program, **students require the permission of their school principal and a minimum mark during the school year of 50 %.**

## Registration

Summer School registration forms will be available in all middle schools and high schools in June. **Registration will take place at Simonds High on Thursday, June 21st and Friday, June 22nd from 8:30AM to 12:00PM and 1:30PM to 3:30PM both days.** All students enrolling in summer school are to report to the Saint John High School auditorium at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012.

## **Tuition Fees**

The tuition fees are as follows:

- Grades 8, 9, & 10 or EAL is \$200 for one or two courses
- Grades 11 & 12 is \$250 for one course or \$300 for two courses

Payment may be made by cash, certified cheque or money order.

**Certified cheques and money orders are to be made payable to "READ Saint John"**

## **Refunds**

A full refund of tuition fees will be issued by July 3rd, 2012 if:

- Summer School is cancelled due to lack of registration.
- A student cannot be timetabled.
- The course/courses in which a student has registered cannot be offered due to lack of registrations.

## **Daily Schedule**

The daily schedule is as follows:

| Period 1: | 8:30 AM to 10:20 AM  |
| Break:    | 10:20 AM to 10:40 AM |
| Period 2: | 10:40 AM to 12:30 PM |

Students enrolled in one course attend Period 1 or Period 2, while students enrolled in two courses attend both periods.

## **Withdrawal Policy**

The following shall be considered sufficient reason for requiring a student to withdraw from Summer School without refund of tuition fees:

- Aggressive, disruptive, disrespectful or other unruly behaviour.
- Not working to his/her maximum.
- Absenteeism (for emergency, sickness or approved absence only) greater than a total of two summer school days.
- Tardiness.
- Failure to do assignments.
- Truancy.

## **Assessment**

Student assessment will be based on assignments, tests and final exams.

## **Textbooks**

Textbooks are loaned to students for use during the Summer School. Students who lose or damage textbooks will be required to pay the replacement/repair cost before final marks are released.
