CONDITIONS

Bursaries will be awarded to students who have successfully completed High School and have been enrolled and accepted in a recognized post secondary educational institution (i.e. University, College, Technical School, Nursing School, etc). **Priority will be given to first-year students with consideration given to students in 2nd, 3rd & 4th year depending on the number of applications received.**

Bursaries will be paid, in the amount of \$1,000.00 to the successful applicants following notification and submission by the applicant of proof that he/she is enrolled in the institution stated on the application. **The bursary cheque will be sent directly to the institution / school and credited to your account.**

The major conditions in the awarding of Bursaries are the following:

- 1. Financial need**
- 2. First year students given priority**
- 3. Children of Ordinary Members of Lancaster Branch 69, Royal Canadian Legion or whose Grandparents or Great Grandparents are / were veterans.**
- 4. Attach a list and \$ amount of Scholarships and other Bursaries the student is receiving.**
- 5. A Letter of Recommendation from the High School**
- 6. An acceptance letter from the post-secondary institution must accompany the application. The name and address of the registrar of the school and Student I D # must accompany the application.**

The decision of the Bursary Committee is FINAL: With the COVID-19 Pandemic restrictions the awarding of the Bursaries may be delayed depending on Government restrictions.

Only Completed Applications received by JULY 14th, 2020 will be considered for this Bursary.
