- Prepare an "activity resume" listing all activities you have been involved in through your high school years (in and out of school)
 - This should list any awards/certifications received
 - Sports/Drama/Clubs/activities you were involved in.
 - Any "Leadership" roles you had within the school
 - o Part time job
 - Volunteer work
 - o If you had excellent attendance
 - Honors/High Honor
- Request at LEAST 2 reference letters from teacher/guidance/coach etc. It
 is always great to have a letter reflecting academic and one possible
 reflecting the extra-curricular side. Pass in a copy of these to the guidance
 center to file in case you need more.
- Request a Transcript from the guidance Center. This is a list of all Credit courses you have taken in High School and the marks you have received in them.
- Complete the application form and have it ready at least one week prior to the deadline (many of these can be done online). Some applications may require further paperwork (letter or essay from you) so please read each application thoroughly.
- Continue to research sites for updated scholarships and bursaries. You can also check with the Career Center, Guidance Office and Edline for updates.
