# A Few Reminders.....

- All schools in ASD-S adhere to a **Scent Free Policy**. This means that strong perfumes, deodorants, sprays (i.e. AXE & TAG) and the like are not permitted in the building. - Please send written excuses if your child misses any time from school. These written excuses are for the home room teacher and help to keep our records up to date.

- Camera phones, recording devices and cameras are not permitted. Devices such as MP3 players, iPods and electronic games are not to be used or seen during instructional time. Electronic games, collector cards and any other items of value or importance are best left at home. St. Martins School assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items.
- Take some time to discuss with your child the rules about playing safe and fair in the playground and in the building in general. St. Martins School has its **Code of Conduct** and these are the guidelines we expect all students to abide by.
