Literacy Tip June: 5 Tips to Prevent the Summer Slide



- 1. **Visit your local library** to select books that both you and your child are interested in reading. Many local libraries put on free reading activities which are fun for the entire family!
- 2. Be sure that your child reads 20 minutes each day. Studies have shown that a child who reads at least 20 minutes/day will learn 1 800 000 words in a year!
- 3. **Set a good example**. When your child sees you reading and enjoying a book, newspaper, or magazine, you are sending a message to your child that reading is important.
- 4. **Read to your child.** When you read to your child, he/she hears the rhythm of language. This will help your build their fluency and expression when they read.
- 5. **Play word games with your child**. Rhyming games can be fun and help your child learn sounds, blends, and patterns in words. Ex: I'm thinking of an animal that rhymes with the word now.... **Cow!**
