## **SEAWOOD SCHOOL STUDENT FEES:**

As a reminder from our school agenda and hand book we are collecting a student fee for the 2013 – 2014 school year. As of this date not all student fees have been received. As stated in our agenda and hand book the fee is \$40.00 per student and \$10.00 for each additional child if you have more than one child attending Seawood School. This fee is to offset the cost of extracurricular activities for the students such as the cost of buses for field trips, admission to the Imperial Theatre, monthly bank fees, field day supplies, food and treats given to the students, sunshine aware prizes, replenish first aid kits (bandages), etc.



**2014 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION:** So far we have 14 students registered for Kindergarten in September 2014. Parents of a child who will turn **five (5) years old by December 31, 2014** are reminded that your child must be registered for Kindergarten for September 2014 at your neighboring school. Please call the school at 658-5366 if you have not already registered your child to receive the necessary instructions. Proof of age and immunizations are required.



<u>PARKING LOT</u> - An important reminder that with the snowy weather we ask that parents do <u>NOT</u> park in the staff parking <u>lot</u> when picking up or dropping off your children. We have limited parking spots available for staff. For the safety of all students the best drop off and pick up location is along Seawood Lane, but please be considerate of private property and drive ways along Seawood Lane. The traffic is lower compared to

Sand Cove Road especially during the winter months when the snow banks are high. Parking is minimal on Sand Cove due to the bus loading and unloading zone. Please help us to keep your children safe when they are arriving and leaving school each day. If you must use Sand Cove Road please remember to park before the main drive way or after the bus stop sign at the front of the school. Remind your children that they should not be cutting through the parking lot. Thank you for your cooperation.



**WINTER WEATHER:** Unless it is very cold or there is extreme weather the students will go outdoors both at recess and lunch time. Please be sure they are properly dressed for winter. Student's clothing and boots should have their name on them as many students have the exact items as other students and they are easily mixed up. Students need inside footwear for the winter season. Also, when the weather is stormy be sure to listen to
